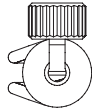
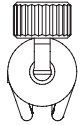


The Old Town Hall has 2 methods of hanging artwork in the galleries

- 1) Moveable panels that are 4ft wide by approximately 10ft high. These panels can be nailed, screwed, and drilled into to hang artwork making them more flexible with hanging requirements. The panels are patched up and painted after each installation.
- 2) A wire and hook system is installed on the perimeter walls of the galleries. NO holes can be made on the perimeter walls; the walls are not patched or painted after each installation. The Old Town Hall provides the hooks and wires for artwork to be hung. Below are images and instructions on how to use the hooks.





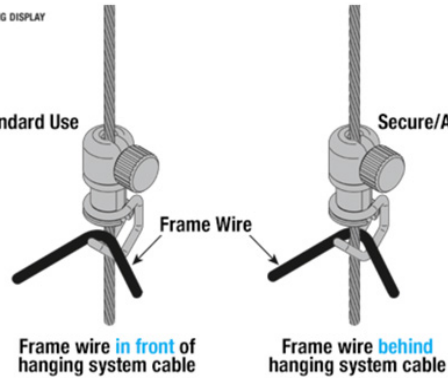
Mini Hook

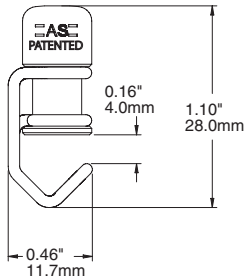
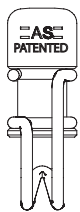
Secure/Anti-Theft Use

The artworks you bring into the gallery must be compatible with our hanging system. Above are the dimensions of the hooks.

The hooks **DO NOT** work with:

Sawtooth hangers, small eye-screws/D-rings, keyholes and horizontal slots

The hooks **DO** work with:

Wire backings and medium-large size D-rings

Please note that if you are using a wire backing the lower the wire is mounted on the frame the more the frame will tilt off the wall. The frame is still secure but it will not be flush with the wall and not be as visually pleasing. It depends on the size, thickness and weight of the frame/canvas but typically 3-4 inches is a good starting point.
