SUBJECT: Film Policy - Parking

ORIGIN: Legislative Services

In accordance with the Procedure Bylaw, any Member of Council may request, through the Clerk that this Information Report be placed on an upcoming Committee of the Whole agenda.

COMMENTS

The purpose of this information report is to advise Members of Council that staff has reviewed the Film Permit Policy to include a map outlining designated parking location for film production company vehicles. The vehicles will be parked along the east side in the P3 East parking lot for downtown parking. The Policy has also been updated to require that a parking permit be displayed on all production vehicles.


There will be circumstances where a production vehicle will need to park in a different location as specified on the map for the filming process which will be approved by the Supervisor of Municipal Enforcement.

When a filming application is received, staff will review the parking requirements and location with the applicant. In addition, a site visit will be undertaken.

On the day of filming, one (1) dedicated parking enforcement officer will be required to be in attendance on site. A fee for dedicated parking enforcement (\$60/hour, minimum of three (3) hour charge) was approved at the November 16, 2015 Special Committee of the Whole meeting (to be considered for approval by Council on November 30, 2015).



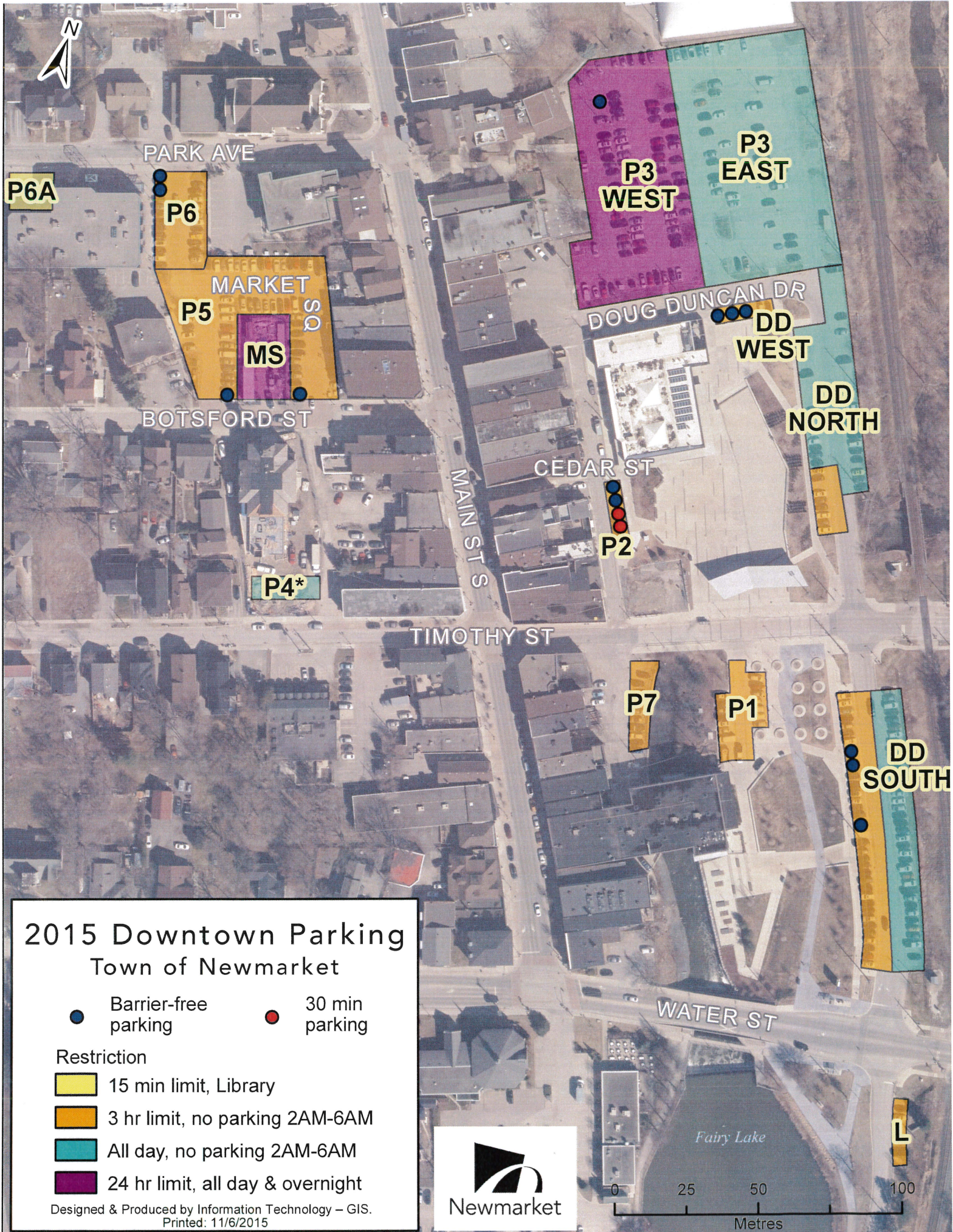
