COMMENTS

The purpose of this information report is to advise Members of Council that the Town has received a noise exemption request from Stickman Knock Productions Inc. regarding filming at 460 Botsford St. and the surrounding streets (Main St., Botsford St.). The request is for an exemption from the Noise By-law 2004-94 on Wednesday June 21, 2017 between approximately 11:00 pm to 2:00 am to simulate a town Halloween festival scene in the immediate front area of the Old Town Hall.
